Do you experience significant fear and avoidance triggered by blood, an injury, receiving an injection or other invasive medical procedures?

Does this interfere with your life?

You may be experiencing Blood-Injection-Injury Phobia (BIIP).

Blood-Injection-Injury Phobia (BIIP) is a fear triggered by blood, an injury, or receiving an injection or medical procedure.

Our BIIP program is a low-cost adult group therapy that could be helpful for you.

In this group you'll learn to challenge your fears in a safe, supportive, and confidential environment. You'll learn evidence-based coping strategies for anxiety and prevent fainting and feelings of disgust.

The program consists of **seven weekly, 2-hour sessions** and a follow-up session one month later.

Cost: \$20 per session
