To help prepare for your exam, we've created a helpful list!

	Select your exam and prepare requirements from the required syllabus.
	<b>Exam Enrolment</b> Enrollers (candidate, teacher, parent, or school) select the chosen exam week as outlined in the Exam Timetable: <b>uwa.edu.au/ameb</b>
	Enter candidate details and make payment in SCORE: <b>wa.ameb.edu.au</b> . If required, include examiner conflict of interest and individual/special needs information and attach supporting medical documentation.
	Please ensure the correct syllabus category is selected (eg Classical and for Leisure, Rockschool), Location (eg Perth, Video Exam), Instrument Family (eg Keyboard, Strings).
	Check all Details  After enrolment, you will receive a confirmation email. Please ensure all details are correct. If the enrolment needs amending, call our team at the AMEB office on 08 6488 3059.
	Notice of Examination In due course, your exam will be scheduled and the Enroller prompted to view the Notice of Examination in SCORE. Ensure you bring a soft or hard copy of this to the exam check-in.
	Upload Repertoire Information Upload your repertoire information into SCORE up to 72 hours prior to your exam. *NB this is not required for Rockschool exams.
	Find a Collaborative Pianist/Accompanist  For most instruments, accompaniment is essential wherever the pieces presented have piano accompaniments (excluding Extra List pieces). AMEB-produced recorded accompaniments are available for many instruments from Preliminary to Grade 3 (AMEB versions must be used when available). If using recorded accompaniments, candidates will be required to bring and operate their own equipment. Ensure that recordings are downloaded as live streaming can be unreliable.
	Proof of Identity (ID) Candidates sitting AMEB Grade 8 and above or Rockschool Grade 6 and above examinations are required to present photographic ID to the supervisor on arrival.
	<b>Exam Arrival &amp; Location</b> Ensure you arrive 15 minutes prior to your exam time. Check your exam venue; whilst most exams are held on the UWA Claremont campus, some exams are held at the main UWA Crawley campus or other external locations.
	<b>Sign-in</b> Please report to the supervisor's desk on arrival for check-in and allocation to a tune-up room where available.
