Scholarships


Scholarships help to support the next generation of lawyers and leaders. In 2022 the Dean's Circle supported an incredible 11 students through a range of scholarships.

Jenna was born to parents who are both competent English speakers, but it is not their first language and as she grew up, she realised that people would attempt to take advantage of them or try to scare them with fake legalese.

She caught Covid this year and has faced other health complications through the year, but this has not gotten in the way of her ambitious goal of finishing the JD in just three years.

Opening of the Paul Bendat Reading Room




