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Title and brief description	SVLGM002 Active Citizenship in Practice. The McCusker Centre for Citizenship partners with more than 400 not-for-profit, community, government and non-government organisations to provide a structured and quality internship program for those who want to become involved and active Citizens. This microcredential is ideally suited to students who cannot complete the equivalent unit as part of their degree. Please note that current UWA students cannot credit this microcredential unit towards their UWA course.
Certified learning	(1) engage in real work in a community context; (2) demonstrate understanding of their professional responsibility to use their knowledge and skills to make a difference in their organisation; (3) discuss how their internship supported their learning about social challenges in the community and their capacity to make a difference; and (4) evaluate opportunities for exchange between the organisation stakeholders and the student, and the benefits gained by both through the internship.
